

# Senior Project: December Write-Up

The next deadline for 2009–2010 mathematics senior projects is **Friday, December 11**. By that date, you must submit 10 pages of your senior project. Here are the details:

- You must submit a PDF file by email to [gregland@bard.edu](mailto:gregland@bard.edu).
- Your file name must include both your first and last names, as in "JohnSmith.pdf", not something generic like "SeniorProject.pdf".
- You must use the Bard Senior Project LaTeX style and template, available from Ethan Bloch's web page at: [http://math.bard.edu/bloch/tex.htm#anc\\_project](http://math.bard.edu/bloch/tex.htm#anc_project)
- The 10 pages requirement counts pages of actual content, not the title page, table of contents, dedication, etc.
- We suggest that you provide chapter and section titles for your whole senior project as best you can, even if you have not written them or even done the research yet. This will help you put together an outline of your whole project. You are not committed to this outline, but it gives you a chance to think about the organization of your project and the direction in which it is heading. For each chapter or section, provide at least one sentence of description. It can be vague, such as "Here we hope to prove the following theorem:", or even more vague as in "Here we will investigate *topic*".
- We suggest that you include references for all sources you have consulted so far. This will give you experience entering references using the AMSRefs system, and makes it possible for you to cite references as you write, rather than adding the references at the last minute.
